THE SEASON SO FAR ...

THE COBBLERS HAVE BEEN IN GREAT FORM SINCE THEIR LAST VISIT TO SIXFIELDS STADIUM.

The dramatic 3-2 win over Lincoln City was the start of a run of eight wins in 10 games which saw Josh Oldfield and Liam Williams' side rapidly climb the table whilst progressing in all three cup competitions.



Northampton were in control as they beat Dronfield Town 6-2 in the Vitality Women's FA Cup first round, and were totally dominant in their 13-0 Northamptonshire FA Women's Cup second round tie against Bugbrooke St. Michaels.

Jade Bell made her debut in the resounding county cup victory, scoring five goals. The forward would go on to take her tally to 17 in just nine appearances across the next few months.





There were positives to take from FA Cup and FA Women's National League Plate exits to strong opposition in Wolverhampton Wanderers and Hull City respectively, and the defeats meant that the Cobblers were able to focus fully on matters in the FAWNL Division One Midlands.



Having not played in the league for almost three months, Oldfield and Williams' team found themselves in the relegation zone. The precarity of the situation failed to phase the squad, who had a 100% record in 2023 until last week.











Solid performances and results against struggling Leek Town (3-1) and then-second-placed Lincoln (2-0) either side of a 7-0 county cup success against Thrapston Town saw Northampton climb out of the drop zone.



The Cobblers leapfrogged Peterborough United into seventh place with a 2-0 win away to Sheffield and an 8-0 victory away to Long Eaton United, meaning they went into their county cup semi-final clash with their rivals unbeaten in six league games and on a run of four consecutive clean sheets in all competitions.

The semi-final ended in disappointment for Oldfield and Williams' side, but it was still a positive afternoon for the club as a whole as the Development squad reached the final with a 3-0 win at home to Moulton FC.



The Cobblers bounced-back from derby day defeat with an impressive 5-0 win over Leafield Athletic in a behind closed doors dress rehearsal at Sixfields, but go into the big day on the back of a 3-1 defeat away to Wem Town.

TODAY'S OPPONENTS SPORTING KHALSA WOMEN

The side currently sit third in the Women's National League Division One Midlands & play their home matches a the Guardian Warehousing Arena.

The club started as a lone side formed in 2004 and initially named Cottage Ladies after a local public house in Walsall which sponsored the team, the following season the Chairwoman of the side Kelly Williams opted to change the name to FC Reedswood after the area in which the club was founded and park the team trained at. The side competed in the Staffordshire County Womens League and slowly improved and built each season to move up the Womens Pyramid, gaining promotion to the West Midlands Regional League Division 1 North, then into the Premier Division. The 13/14 season saw FC Reedswood promoted to the FA Womens National League, set up a Development Team and U18's team.





The 14/15 season saw them finish 8th following promotion and it was the end of this season where they requested a name change and to join Sporting Khalsa FC and form their Women's and Girls section. Since then the Women's and Girls section has grown with almost a full pathway to the Women's Teams and has a successful Weetabix Wildcats Centre. The side's best finish in tier 4 was a 3rd place finish in 16/17, they reached the 4th round of the Womens FA Cup in 14/15, reached the Semi-Final of the FAWNL Plate in 2021/22 and have reached the Staffordshire County Cup Final 8 times in the last 11 years.
