- Maintaining administrative records and confidentiality where appropriate.
- Support for the team/colleagues on matchdays.
- Ensuring safety for all participants by undertaking health and safety checks before each activity and adopting the Community Trust's safeguarding procedures.
- Ensuring that any and all safeguarding concerns are recorded and reported/passed on to the NTFC CT Designated Safeguarding Officer immediately.
